William Harrison Henry was born on May 13, 1804 in Virginia. He was the son of John Henry of Scotland and Elizabeth Bennett of Virginia. William married Sarah Schumacher. She was born on April 24, 1802 in Augusta County, Virginia.

William and Sarah moved with their family from Green County, Ohio to Springfield Township, Cedar County, Iowa about 1849. William was a farmer.

According to the 1850 Springfield Township, Cedar County, Iowa census record, William Henry was 44 and born in Virginia. Sarah was 46 and born in Virginia. Their children were John age 21; Samuel age 20; Margaret age 18; Hannah age 12; Sarah age 8; and William age 6. William, John, and Samuel were farmers. William and Sarah's son James and his family were the next family listed on the census. James was 23 and born in Ohio. He was a farmer. His wife Mira was 28. Their children were Nicodemus age 5; William age 3; and Andrew J. age 1. Hannah and Sarah were attending school. Sarah age 46 and Mira could not read and write.

William was listed in the 1852 Springfield Township, Cedar County, Iowa census.

According to the 1856 Springfield Township, Cedar County, Iowa census record, William Henry was 52 and born in Virginia. He was a farmer and had been in Iowa for 7 years. His wife Sarah was 54 and born in Virginia. Their children were John age 26; Margaret age 23; Hannah age 17; Sarah age 13; and William age 12. John was also a farmer. James Henry was the head of the family before William's family in the census. James was also the son of William and Sarah. James was 29 and born in Ohio. He was a farmer and a widow. He had been in Iowa for 6 years. His children were Nicodemus age 11; William J. age 10; Andrew J. age 8; James H. age 6; John W. age 3; and Musettia A. no age given. Nicodemus, William J., and Andrew J. were born in Ohio. James H., John W., and Musettia A. were born in Iowa. The statistics for William's farm were as follows: 10 acres of unimproved land; amount of improved land unreadable; 8 tons of hay; 21 acres and 345 bushels of spring wheat harvested; 5 acres and 240 bushels of oats harvested; 16 acres and 200 bushels of corn harvested; \(^{1}_{4}\) acre and 55 bushels of potatoes harvested; 6 hogs sold for 88 dollars; no cattle; 200 pounds of butter manufactured; 48 pounds of wool; 12 dollars of domestic manufacture; and 0 dollars of general manufacture.

William and Sarah moved from Springfield Township, Cedar County, Iowa to northwest of Ridgeway, Harrison County, Missouri. They lived about 1 ½ miles from the Ridgeway. William was a farmer. The family lived in a log cabin. They operated a brick kiln which was just north of their home.

According to the 1860 Union Township, Harrison County, Missouri census record, William was 57 and born in Virginia. He was a farmer. His real estate was worth 2000 dollars and his personal estate was worth 1500 dollars. Sarah was 60 and born in Virginia. She could not read or write. Their children were John age 29, Sarah age 18, and William age 19. John and William were farm hands. William and Sarah's adult children and their families were listed below them in the census: Frederic and Margaret (Henry) Rake; Frederic and Hannah (Henry) Reddinger; and Samuel and Margaret Henry. Margaret was 28 and born in Ohio; Hannah was 22 and born in Ohio; and Samuel was 30 and born in Ohio.

According to the 1870 Union Township, Harrison County, Missouri census record, William was 66 and born in Virginia. He was a farmer. His real estate was worth 2850 dollars

and his personal estate was worth 1120 dollars. His wife Sarah was 68 and born in Virginia. She was keeping house. Their son William H. was 24 and born in Ohio. He was a farmer. His real estate was worth 1400 dollars and his personal estate was worth 920 dollars. His wife Eliza was 26 and born in Missouri. She was keeping house. Their children were Samuel S. age 5, Sheridan (male) age 4, and Matilda A. age 1. All the children were born in Missouri. Frederic and Margaret Rake and family were on the same page of the census as William and Sarah. Margaret was their daughter. William H. and Sarah could not write.

According to the 1880 Marion Township, Harrison County, Missouri census record, William was 76 and born in Virginia. His parents were born in Virginia. He was a farmer and had palsy. Sarah was 79 and born in Virginia. Her parents were born in Virginia. She was doing housework. They had a servant named Frank Framer who was 24 and born in Illinois. He did farm work. Their son John and his family was the next family in the census. William and Ellen Henry were also on the same page of the census. William was their son.

William and Sarah donated one half of the land that became the Ridgeway Cemetery. William died on September 5, 1881 in Harrison County, Missouri and Sarah died on April 24, 1888 in Harrison County, Missouri. They were buried in the Ridgeway Cemetery in Ridgeway.

He died on January 29, 1912 in Ridgeway, Harrison County, Missouri. Hannah died on February 19, 1917 in Ridgeway, Harrison County, Missouri. She had an infection of the gall bladder.
